Biodiversity and Landscape Grant



Guidance Notes

The Biodiversity and Landscape Grant has two main aims:-

- To conserve and enhance the biodiversity of South Gloucestershire
- To conserve and enhance the landscape character of South Gloucestershire

Who can apply?

Landowners, farmers and parish councils.

What grants are available?

Grant aid is available up to 50% of project costs, up to a maximum grant of £500 for the creation, restoration and management of a range of habitats and landscape features. Eligible projects include:

- Pond creation or renovation
- Creation and restoration of ditches and other wetlands
- Native tree and shrub planting
- Creating new native mixed-species hedgerows
- Restoration of dry stone walls within public view
- Hedge laying and hedgerow management
- Pollarding
- Grassland restoration and management
- Management of traditional orchards
- Traditional woodland management including coppicing
- Works that help arrest and reverse the decline of priority habitats and species as set out in the South Gloucestershire Biodiversity Action Plan. (A copy is available on the Council's website at www.southglos.gov.uk/biodiversity)

Conditions of grant

The proposed work must be within the administrative area of South Gloucestershire Council

Works must enhance the landscape character and/or biodiversity of South Gloucestershire

Works should not result in the loss of existing semi-natural habitats

Where applications involve tree and shrub planting grant aid will only be available for native tree and shrub species included in the list at the end of these guidance notes

Three independent quotations should be submitted with your application. These must be fully itemised – single lump sum figures are not acceptable. Please note that you must ensure this documentation covers all your anticipated costs. Once a grant is offered additional costs cannot be considered.

The grant offer must be accepted in writing by the applicant before works are undertaken. The offer only remains current for three months

Works should be undertaken within one year of the date of the grant offer

Applicant must protect, maintain and replace trees (if necessary) and allow for inspection, for three years after planting

Maximum area of tree planting per site 0.25 hectares (0.6 acres). Applicants should apply to the Forestry Commission for grant support for tree planting areas over this size

Only one successful grant application can be made per financial year

Where more than one grant application is submitted within a period of three financial years, the applicant should submit a habitat management plan or landscape strategy for all land in his/her ownership

Grants cannot be matched with other Government funded grant schemes

Grants are not available for undertaking work for commercial profit or to satisfy a condition of any planning consent. Schemes on land proposed for development in local planning policies or that are subject of a planning application will not be eligible for grant aid

The site must not be located in a private garden

Reasonable access to the site must be permitted to Officers of South Gloucestershire Council for a period of up to three years from the date of the grant being paid for the purpose of monitoring the biodiversity or landscape enhancement

Appropriate projects may be used to publicise the scheme in press releases or exhibitions

Grants will be paid on satisfactory completion of the work and submission of a receipted invoice.
