# Caring for Others Survey 2012 Local Results

This national survey was issued by The Health & Social Care Information Centre.


The results of the survey will be used by the Care Quality Commission, the Department of Health, the Health and Social Care Information Centre and South Gloucestershire's Children, Adults & Health Department to see how happy people are with their support and services. There is a need to find out how services received by carers are helping them in their caring role and their life outside of caring, and also their perception of services provided to the cared for person.

#### Carers in South Gloucestershire:

There are over 27,636 carers in South Gloucestershire

- 5,384 are providing unpaid care for 50 hours or more a week
- Currently 1,300 South Gloucestershire adult carers are known to the council's Children, Adults and Health department (CAH)
- 2,290 carers are known to the Carers Support Centre

In October last year 392 surveys were sent out to carers who had received an assessment in their own right from South Gloucestershire Council.




Overall, how satisfied or dissatisfied are you with the support or services you and the person you care for have received from Community Care in the last 12 months?


Age bands & gender of carer (taken off South Gloucestershire Council records)






#### Which of the following statements best describes how you spend your time?



## Which of the following statements best describes how much control you have over your daily life?





Thinking about how much time you have to look after yourself – in terms of getting enough sleep or eating well – which statement best describes your present situation?





Thinking about your personal safety, which of the statements best describes your present situation? By 'personal safety' we mean feeling safe from fear of abuse, being attacked or other physical harm.





Thinking about how much social contact you've had with people you like, which of the following statements best describes your social situation?







Do you feel you have been involved or consulted as much as you wanted to be, in discussions about the support or services provided to the person you care for?




















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### Where does the person you care for usually live?


### Does the person you care for have....
