This guide provides an overview of all transport options in Bradley Stoke and the surrounding areas.



The map overlaid shows all bus services, the train stations and cycle paths. The bus services are colour coded to help you.



A summary of services is shown in the **Bus Frequency Guide** below which includes approximate daytime and evening frequencies for all days of the week.

Daytime means up to **6pm** and Evenings from **6pm**.

The numbers shown indicate how often the buses run. For example the number **30** would show that a bus runs every **30 minutes**, **120** indicates a bus every **2 hours**.

For all bus services, generally a Sunday service applies on Public Holidays.

Bus services which also stop at a station are indicated with the symbol  and hospitals are indicated by .

Bus services which are mainly wheelchair accessible are indicated with  and those which have low floor buses for most journeys are indicated with , however please check with the operator before travelling.

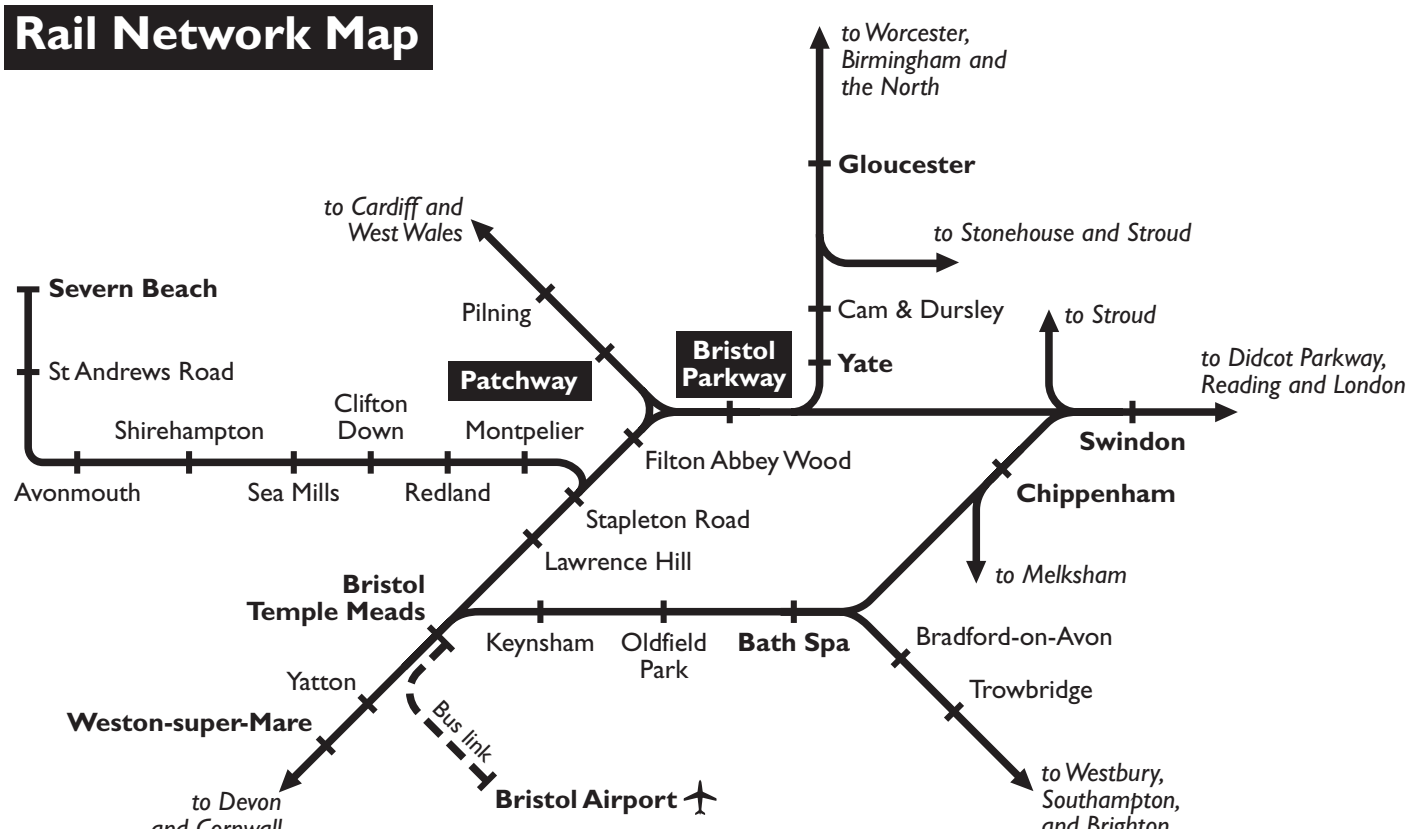

This information is correct at time of printing and subject to change. For the most up-to-date fare information please contact the operator. Adult Day Return (off-peak) is valid from 9am, peak fares apply before 9am.

Don't forget, if you plan to use the bus regularly there are several options such as day tickets which enable you to use an operator's service all day for just one price. Weekly, monthly and annual passes are usually available which can provide substantial savings. Contact the operator for details.

Season tickets and other discounts are also available for rail travellers, contact National Rail enquiries for details.

Getting around Bradley Stoke and surrounding areas

In addition to public transport, the following options are available:

Yate, Sodbury & District Community Transport

Community transport provides transport for those who find it difficult to use conventional bus services. The council supports these services and for those who have a Diamond Travelcard the dial-a-ride service is free of charge.

Four Towns and Vale Link Community Transport

Thornbury and communities to the west of the M5 are mainly served by Four Towns and Vale link community transport.

The Diamond Travelcard

If you are 60 or over, or eligible disabled, you can apply for a bus pass providing free off-peak travel on local buses anywhere in England.

Youth Concessionary Fares

Young people aged 14-18 living in South Gloucestershire can apply for the Youth United bus pass which entitles them to half adult fare on journeys starting or finishing within South Gloucestershire – terms and conditions apply. For more information see www.southglos.gov.uk/youthunited

Taxi

There are two types of taxi: hackney carriages and private hire vehicles.

The council sets fares charged by hackney carriages, whilst private hire vehicles operate on the basis that the fare is agreed between the driver and the customer

PlusBUS

There are currently two PlusBUS stations convenient to the South Gloucestershire area: Bristol Parkway and Bristol Temple Meads. Customers should ask for a PlusBUS ticket when booking their rail tickets.

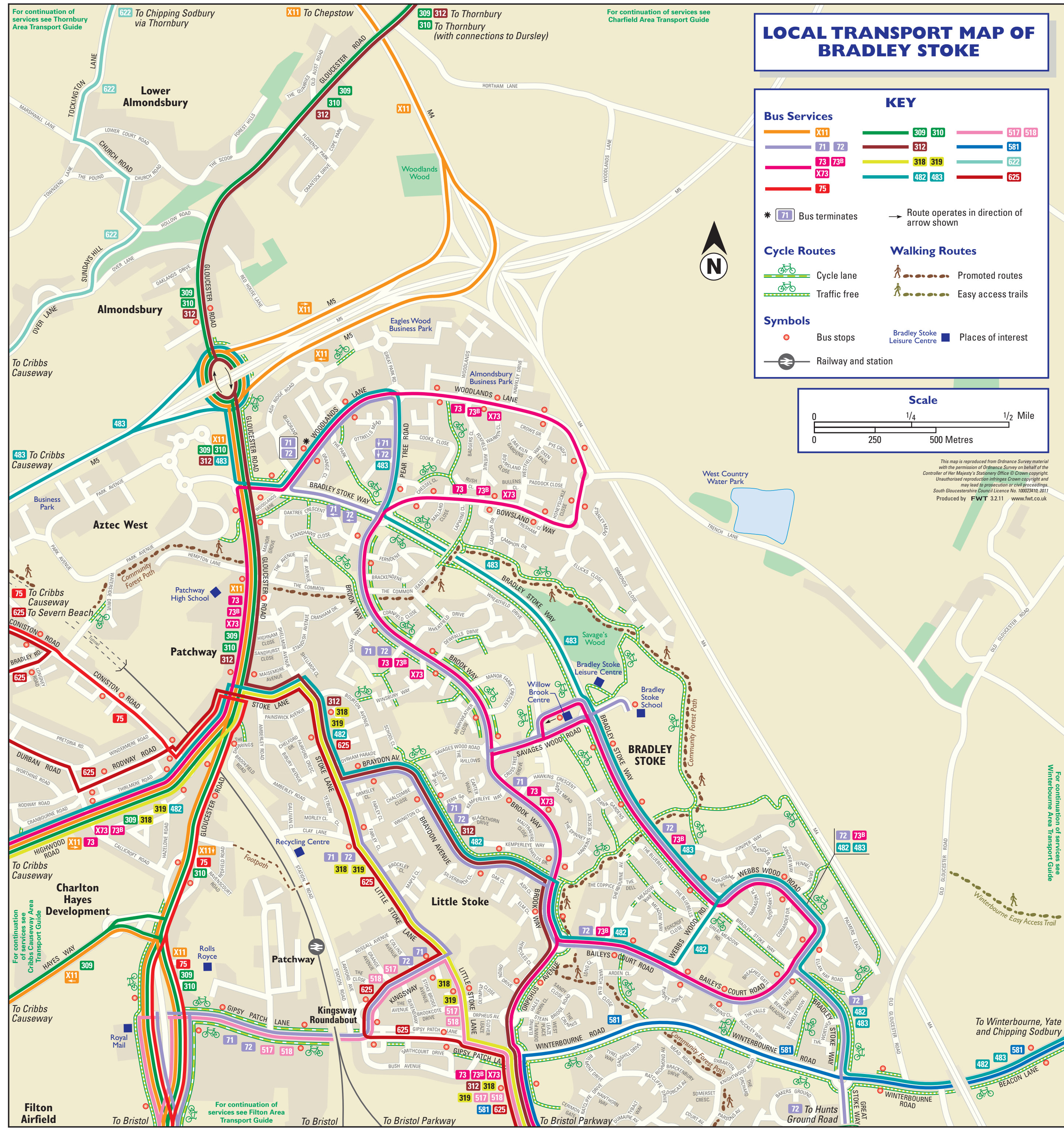

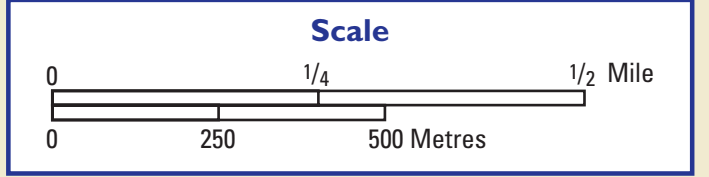

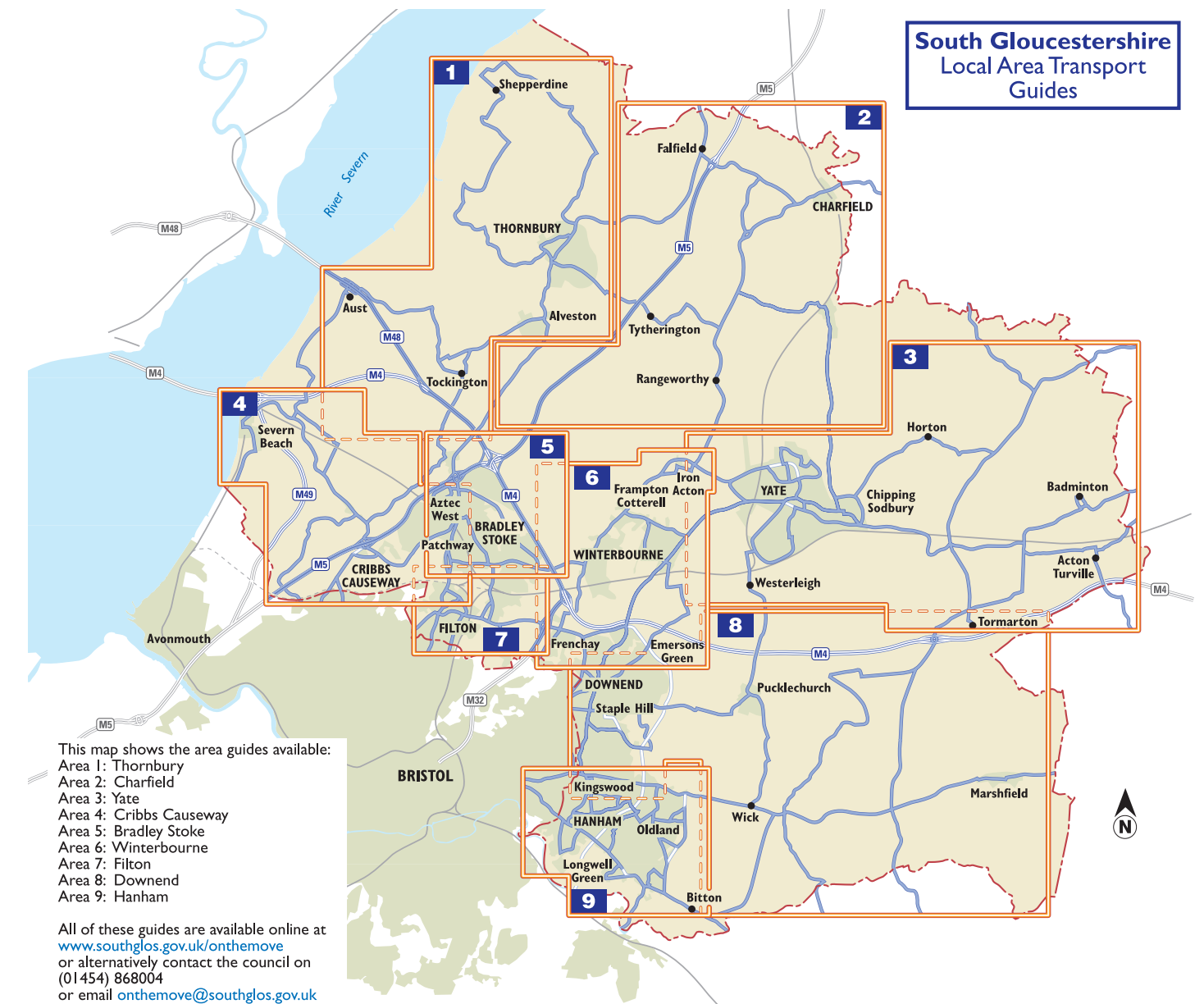
Making a complaint about bus services
If you have a complaint about a bus service then contact the operator direct, or if the complaint is about a council subsidised service you should also contact the council.

The Bus Appeals Body, the industry's non-statutory body, can also deal with complaints about operational issues, such as poor reliability, the bus not turning up at all, drivers or other staff being rude, etc.

It cannot deal with commercial issues, like fares and service levels, ticketing and timetabling, or routings, nor can it help if the issue has involved the Police or other legal authority.

You must always have written to the company first to give them a chance to sort out the issue.
