WHAT ARE WE DOING?

We are planning to upgrade the cycling and walking infrastructure around Avonmouth Severnside Enterprise Area (ASEA). The package of measures will support the development of a new junction on the M49 and the economic and commercial development in the area.

Improvement measures include:



Enhancements to the Cycleway Network Route 4 between Cribbs Causeway and Severn Beach



Lower speed limits in Severn Beach and parts of Piling



New crossings at various locations



Surfacing and junction improvements



Bus stop upgrades



Permanent closure of Hollywood Lane

The proposals are being brought forward by Highways England, Sustrans and South Gloucestershire Council.

Works are planned to start in summer 2019 and will take approximately 12 months.
