

Continue along on the left side of the cycle path until you reach a crossing. Safely cross through the gates and follow the path all the way to Avon Valley Railway where you will be able to purchase refreshments\* and have a well earned rest! (\*subject to opening hours)



## Return journey

Leave Avon Valley Railway, turn left and walk back down the cycle path towards Oldland - keeping left. Continue until the railway crossing and before you go through gate, look back at buffers.

**12** Can you name three items available in the station buffet?



Answer

Check for trains, cross track through gate and continue along opposite path.

**13** Who was Charles Moore on 'Rocks & Railways' sign?

Answer

Follow path for approx. 0.25 mile until you get to a gateway on the left before Viaduct Bridge. Go through the gateway, turn right and down the steps, turning left at bottom towards St Anne's Church and the wooden bridge.

**14** Who made the bridge?

Answer

Cross the bridge and turn right down lane. Pick up a stick! In about 100m, cross stone bridge on right and play Pooh Sticks to see who wins! Then safely cross the road being careful for traffic and follow the path towards the common.



**15** What does this stone commemorate?

Answer

**16** Turn right on to common and tell us where you can find this bridge?



Answer (nearest sign)

## Just for fun

- Along the way, can you scavenger hunt 10 different coloured items?  
E.g. leaves, feathers, bottle tops etc...

Follow all the way across the common, through trees, over bridge and back around the edge of the golf course, turning left at the car park. Cross back over the golf course, cross Brereton Road, follow Queen's Road, back past the shops and return to Cadbury Heath Library.

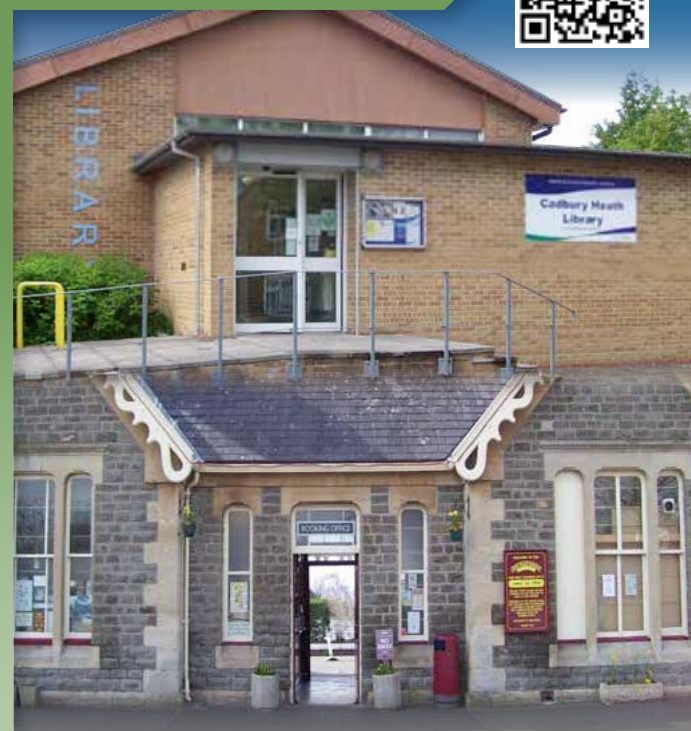

Cadbury Heath Library to Avon Valley Railway loop

This is a short treasure trail just for fun taking in the picturesque Bristol and Bath Railway path and Avon Valley Railway which runs regular steam trains.

This is a circular walk of approximately three miles. It is a mainly flat route suitable for those with young children, but due to steps on the route it is not accessible for those with buggies or wheelchairs. There are toilets and refreshments available at Avon Valley railway during opening hours.

# The trail

Leave the library and turn left along School Road to the shops, turn right at the end by the chip shop.

**1** What is the community building round the corner where you 'can't get a drink'?

Answer

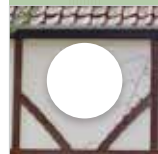
Continue down Queen's Road, safely cross Brereton Way and follow the path through the middle of the golf course towards the hire hut and car park.



**2** Look up, Look down, where is this found?

Answer

At the main road, follow the path around the golf course, between the wall and the fence. Continue over the bridge and round to the right, through the trees. Follow the path until trees open out, half-way across common, turn left when the paths cross and go up the steps to Fairway Close - turn left at top of the steps.



**3** How many steps do you climb?

Answer

Follow this road until a grassy island where you turn right towards Westcourt Drive then turn left at the end.

**4** What is this sign warning you of?

Answer

Check for traffic and carefully cross over Westcourt Drive, turn right at the end of the road and walk along West Street.

**5** What number bus would you catch to UWE?

Answer

**6** Why are there handprints in the wall at number 48?

Answer

**7** At the Methodist Church, who laid the memorial stone and when?

Answer

Continue along road until you reach Oldland Village club and safely cross the road.

**8** Where will you find this plaque?

Answer

Continue along on left side of road towards the cycle path. Be careful going down the steep steps and turn right on to the Bristol to Bath cycle path. (Please keep to the left along this path)

**9** At the crossing for St Anne's School, what time do you have to use caution?

Answer

Continue walking towards along the cycle path.

**11** Look up, Look down, where is this found?

Answer (nearest bridge name)
