Choices 4 U is a service for people with learning difficulties. We work with people from the age of 16 years old. We support people to live a healthy and independent life.

We will support you to:



Learn skills to be more independent

- This is about learning things that can help you to be more independent and confident in your daily life like travel, cooking and planning things.



Live a healthy life - This is about doing things in life that can help you to be healthy. Like healthy eating, exercise and talking to someone when things change in your life.



Have friendships and relationships

- This is about supporting you to have friendships and find out what is going on in the community so that you are more connected to others.

Think about getting into work

- This is about supporting you to think about work and helping you get the right support when you are ready to find a job.



Get the most out of your service -

This is about making sure we are a good service and support people in the right way.

Who will support you at Choices 4 U?



Choices 4 U have a team of Community Support Workers who have experience and skills to support you.

How does the service work?



If you are interested in finding out more about Choices 4 U you can fill out a referral form or someone can fill it out for you, this might be a Carer or a Social Worker. Once we have your form we will contact you and arrange to meet with you. You can also contact Choices 4 U by telephone or by email.

If you are interested you can come to Choices 4 U for a taster day to see if you like it.



You will be supported to create an individual plan. This plan will show us your needs, goals and choices. We would use this to find out what you want to get from your service at Choices 4 U and how we can support you to do this.



We will look at your plan regularly to see if things have changed.

Where is Choices 4 U?

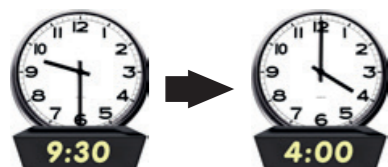
Choices 4 U use leisure centres as a base to work from.



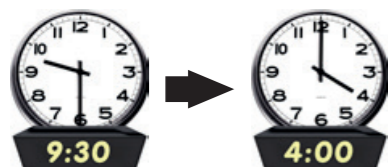
- **Kingswood Leisure Centre**

Some activities are at the leisure centre using the gym, swimming pool and sports hall. We also go out into the community to use other places to do activities.

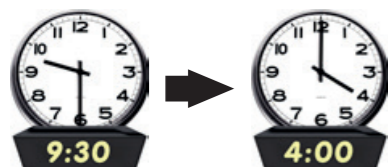
When is Choices 4 U?



- **Choices 4 U at Kingswood**
Runs 3 days a week
Monday, Wednesday and Friday
9.30am – 4.00pm



- **Choices 4 U at Yate**
Runs 3 days a week
Tuesday, Thursday and Friday
9.30am – 4.00pm



- **Choices 4 U at Bradley Stoke -**
Runs 2 days a week
Tuesday and Thursday
9.30am – 4.00pm

We are not open on bank holidays.

How will I get there?



You will have to decide how to get to Choices 4 U, and how to get home again.

You may use a bus, a taxi, walk or have support from a Carer or Support Worker to get there.

How much will it cost?



To attend Choices for you it will cost you:

£46.50 to attend for a full day
or
£23.30 to attend for half a day

If you have other health or personal care needs you will have to bring a Support Worker with you while you attend the service.

£34.90 to attend for a full day with a support worker
or
£17.40 to attend for half a day with a support worker
