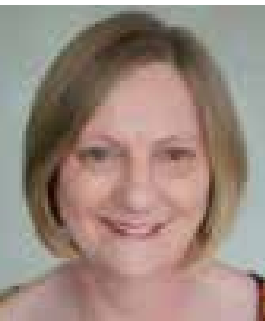
Elizabeth Jarman
