

NOTICE OF ELECTION

UK Parliamentary General Election for the Thornbury and Yate Constituency

1. An Election is to be held of **One** Member of Parliament for Thornbury and Yate.
2. Forms of nomination for the Parliamentary Election may be obtained at The Kington Room, Turnberries Community Centre, Bath Road, Thornbury, BS35 2BB from the Acting Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer at The Kington Room, Turnberries Community Centre, Bath Road, Thornbury, BS35 2BB **on any day after the date of this notice (excluding weekends) between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm but no later than 4 pm on Thursday 11th May 2017.**
4. The £500 required deposit may be made either by the deposit of any legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom.
5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 8th June 2017.**
6. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Council Offices, Badminton Road, Yate, BS37 5AF **by 5 pm on Tuesday 23rd May 2017.**
7. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Council Offices, Badminton Road, Yate, BS37 5AF **by 5 pm on Wednesday 31st May 2017.**
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **by 5 pm on Thursday 8th June 2017.** The physical incapacity must have occurred **after 5 pm on Wednesday 31st May 2017.** To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person **after 5 pm on Wednesday 31st May 2017.**
