

# The Road to Nowhere

The Road to Nowhere in Yate was originally part of a scheme to create a bypass road, however the scheme was only partially completed which has left us with a unique empty stretch of dual carriageway.

Bordered on all sides by fields and trees from Yate Common and Farmland, the Road to Nowhere offers real flexibility. It can be shot as a dual carriageway, or as a single lane country road. This site offers a film-maker complete control over location without the need for a road closure.

## Key Features

- No traffic
- Common Land and Farmland surrounding
- Large unit base area, out of view from the road
- Could be shot as a two lane or dual carriageway

## Location:

- 400m of unused carriageway with space for a large unit base
- Built in 1974

## Facilities

- Close to popular shopping centre
- Large area to park vehicles – please note that parking is not available on the Common
- No toilets on site
- Gated access by road including lorry access
- Preparation works such as cutting back of vegetation and white line painting can be arranged at a cost.

Previous filming on this site includes Broadchurch, Casualty, Skins, CBBC and other various independent filming.
