South Gloucestershire communities will once again come together to take part in the annual Spring Clean campaign. This year's campaign takes place between **Monday 11 February and Friday 10 May**.

Last year, local parks friends groups, resident associations, schools, churches, town and parish councils, brownie/guide and scout groups, youth and community groups, StreetCare office staff and local councillors all took part in the campaign to help improve their local environment.

Free gloves and refuse bags are available and groups can borrow litter pickers and hoops. However, please be aware that we only have a limited number of these which will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Keep Britain Tidy is also running its Spring Clean campaign between **March 22 and April 23 2019**, and you may wish to register your event with them as well.

## Disposing of waste from your Spring Clean

If you have the resources yourself, you can take your filled refuse bags to your local Sort It centre. It's much easier to separate recyclable and non-recyclable litter into different sacks during your tidy up rather than after. Please request some clear plastic bags to separate cans and plastic bottles for recycling. Alternatively you can arrange for South Gloucestershire Council's street cleansing team to collect the sealed bags from your Spring Clean event.
