South Gloucestershire Council Taxi Policy 2010

Amendment of driving assessment requirement for new applicants

South Gloucestershire Council was in receipt of a letter from DVSA, dated 31 August 2016, stating that Taxi Driver Assessment provision will be withdrawn on 31 December 2016.

On 8 December 2016, the Regulatory Committee were presented with a report to consider and agree a proposed amendment to the current Taxi Policy in relation to the requirement for a Taxi Driver Assessment, with the cessation of the DVSA Taxi Driver Assessment on 31 December 2016, and how this will affect applicants for new Hackney Carriage and Private Hire driver's licences.

The reason that this was necessary, is that the requirement to pass a DVSA Taxi Driver Assessment test is part of this Licensing Authority's current Taxi Policy, section 7.7, in relation to Hackney Carriage and Private Hire drivers, that all new applicants must pass a DVSA Taxi Driver Assessment as a prerequisite to being granted a driver's licence in the South Gloucestershire District.

The DVSA Taxi Driver Assessment, introduced on 1 April 2008, is designed to test the skills required to drive hackney carriage and private hire vehicles safely and includes assessment of awareness and anticipation, effective planning relating to road traffic conditions, correct use of speed, passenger safety and comfort, taxi manoeuvres and a special taxi related exercise.

Following initial contact with respective service providers and reviewing the assessment/test criteria set out by each, three service providers/assessors have been identified which the Licensing Service proposed to carry out Hackney Carriage/Private Hire Driver Assessments to the same standard of the current DVSA Taxi Driver Assessment. These service providers are:

The Regulatory Committee were advised that the Licensing Service are conscious that the current service demand for driver applications is at an all-time high, and does not wish to place further barriers in front of applicants seeking potential employment, therefore three potential service providers/assessors gives choice and reduces the risk of significant waiting times.

The Licensing Service was of the opinion that no formal consultation process be required as the proposal is an amendment to the current Taxi Policy, to an equivalent standard. The Regulatory Committee were also given the option to remove the driving assessment requirement from the Taxi Policy.

The Regulatory Committee agreed the following:

- 1) That this Licensing Authority continues to require all new applicants for Hackney Carriage and Private Hire driver's licences to take and pass a Taxi Driver Assessment test equivalent to the current standard required by the DVSA Taxi Driver Assessment;
- 2) That new applicants for Hackney Carriage and Private Hire driver's licences have flexibility to choose from the three agreed provider/assessors at the standard of the current DVSA Taxi Driver Assessment; and
- 3) That this Licensing Authority continues to reserve the right to require an existing South Gloucestershire Council licensed driver to take a Taxi Driver Assessment if, with evidence, it becomes necessary for remedial purposes.

The Licensing Authority has been in contact with and agreed partnership working arrangements with the three service providers named above, and new driver applicants in South Gloucestershire are now able to book a driving assessment test with their chosen service provider/assessor. Booking arrangements are stated on each respective service provider website, along with contact details should they be required.
