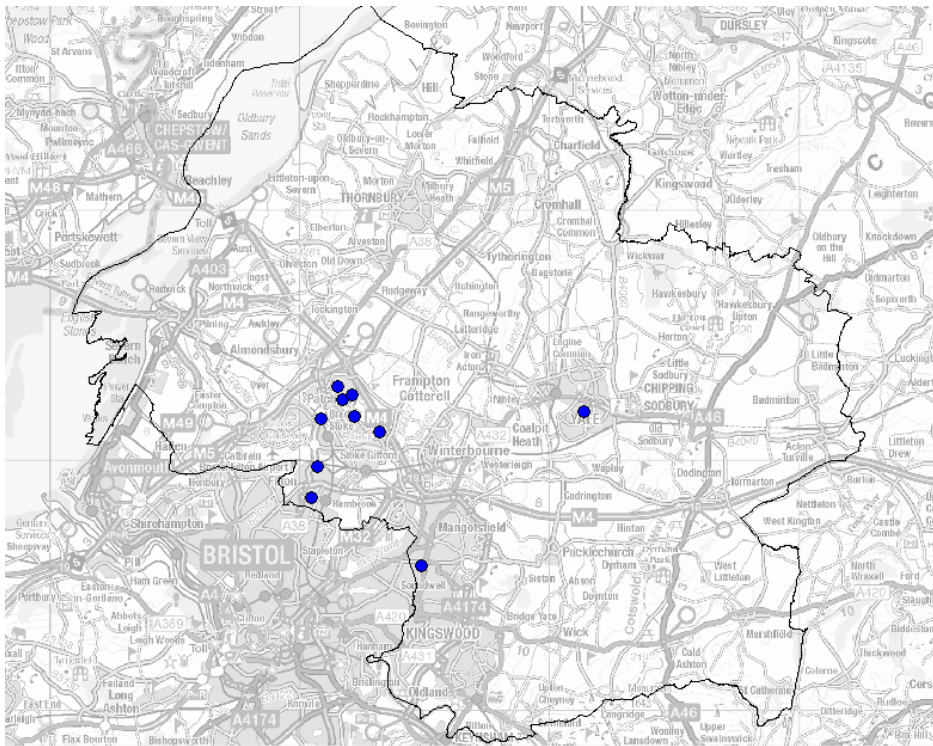


Fig 1 Distribution of schools where over 20% of Pupils have English as an Additional Language (EAL)

Fig 1 shows that the schools are predominantly concentrated around the North Bristol Fringe (Bradley Stoke, Patchway & Filton)
