Born: 1892 35 Sunnyside. Hambrook. **(Died 1923)**

Lived: 25 North Street, Downend. Gloucestershire.

Emigrated to Canada 1912

Herbert was always called Bert. He emigrated to Canada as many did in 1912 when the Canadian government advertised for workers, he probably had financial help towards his ticket. Bert is thought to have died of pneumonia in Hamilton, Ontario, Canada in 1923.

Arthur Hill is the first boy on the left in the back row, there are more Flux children there too.
