

Lyde Green Primary and Secondary School Provision

This stakeholder update follows [the last update from South Gloucestershire Council of 30 July 2021](#) and has been issued to support the [Update for Winterbourne Academy Parents and Carers issued by The Olympus Academy Trust on 25 August 2021](#).

The new secondary school at Lyde Green for children aged 11 to 16 school is being developed in a partnership between South Gloucestershire Council, the Department for Education and the newly appointed sponsor trust, the Olympus Academy Trust.

As part of the pre-opening phase, the council welcomes the plans to temporarily co-locate the Year 7 cohort on the Winterbourne Academy School site. This means that the new Lyde Green Secondary School will open for children in September 2022 and parents/carers will be able to express a preference for Lyde Green in their admission application for secondary transfer in September 2022.

Under this arrangement, children offered places for Lyde Green Secondary School will have access to a full curriculum and the use of some of Winterbourne's facilities. The council is supporting the project to provide the necessary interim classroom accommodation.

Transport will be provided by South Gloucestershire Council between Lyde Green and Winterbourne for all students who need it during 2022-23 until the permanent building is ready to occupy.

The council and Olympus Academy Trust will hold information sessions for families interested in places and wanting to hear more detail. These will take place in a local venue towards the end of September.
