

PUCKLECHURCH B4465 Shortwood Hill & Shortwood Road Shared Use Path Phases 1 and 2

Progress of works for the first phases of a new shared path for pedestrians, horse riders and cyclists; linking Pucklechurch to the existing cycle network at Emersons Green.

Phase 1 has extended the existing cycle track towards Pucklechurch from where it finished before the Shortwood Hill junction, on to the layby past Gingells Farm. Thanks to the Local Sustainable Transport Fund, construction of this much needed link commenced during winter 2014/15.

Phase 2 consists of new path alongside the layby, through Siston Lane junction and on past Horseshoe Cottage. Two thirds of this second phase has now been constructed thanks to Area Forum Funds, land sale funds and New Homes Bonus grant recently awarded following a bid from Pucklechurch Parish Council. Works to complete the final third of Phase 2 from the east side of Siston Lane to a point just past Horseshoe Cottage will resume on the 28 July and it is anticipated to be complete by early October 2015. We would like to thank residents and public for their continued patience over the summer months whilst further design and preparation work is undertaken and a more appropriate termination point for Phase 2 is constructed. Pucklechurch bound users of the path will be advised to rejoin the carriageway at Siston Lane until Phase 2 works are complete.
