It is not too late to sign up! The Time 4 Reading Awards are available to all primary and secondary schools in South Gloucestershire. The aim is to encourage enjoyment of reading across school communities.

Time 4 Reading awards criteria:

- All schools are eligible to take part.
- Schools work through stages, starting at Bronze and concluding with Gold.
- For primary schools each stage is made up of two sections: part A and B.
- When a stage has been completed, application forms should be submitted to Helean Hughes at: helean.hughes@southglos.gov.uk
- Successful schools will receive a certificate in recognition of their achievement
- Award winning schools will receive recognition on the South Gloucestershire Time 4 Reading website and social media channels: www.southglos.gov.uk/time4reading
